NOTES

- For details on the Central Nippon Expressway Pass (CEP), please contact the respective rental car agency, or use the form below. <http://highwaypost.c-nexco.co.jp/sys/inquiry/en-entry/agree>
- In the cases below, CEP does not cover the entire use of the area whether a section covered by CEP was partially traveled or not.
 - Entering and exiting outside CEP service areas.
 - Use outside the preregistered period.
- If you enter at an interchange within a CEP service area and exit at an interchange outside a service area, or enter at an interchange outside a service area and exit at an interchange within a service area, CEP does not cover use of the section outside CEP service areas, and a separate expressway toll will be charged upon return of the rental car and ETC card. Note that it may take a while to confirm use of the expressway and to calculate additional tolls not covered by CEP.
- Before using CEP, read and consent to the usage agreement and ETC system regulations. You cannot change or cancel the CEP period after using it.
- Even if you are using CEP, the normal toll is displayed when passing a toll booth. If you meet the CEP conditions, the toll displayed will be not charged, and you only have to pay for a fixed toll.
- During winter (December - March), you should use rental cars equipped with studless tires.

Advice on operating a GPS car navigation system! Destination setting

- Set your operating language by selecting a "language" (言語) from "setting" (設定).
- Destination setting is best done with a phone number or a map code. Every tourist facility listed in this booklet has a corresponding map code. For information on how to operate the car navigation system of your rental car, please contact your car rental company, because the operation method varies depending on the car navigation model.

Central Nippon Expressway Pass How to enter an expressway (through a tollgate).

Rent an ETC card (expressway toll card) beforehand from your car rental company, then enter the expressway through an "ETC dedicated" lane or an "ETC / general" lane. In certain situations, such as when your car is not able to pass through the ETC lane smoothly due to a communication error, please use a "general" lane, pull out the ETC card from your rental car's on-board ETC device, and wait for a tollbooth operator to attend to the situation. Please drive through ETC lanes at 20 km/h or less.



Japanese traffic signs which should be remembered

- One-way street**: You must drive only in the direction indicated by the arrow. You must not enter the street from the opposite direction.
- 止まれ (STOP)**: You must temporarily stop before the stop line or the intersection.

Traffic rules to be noted!

Note1 In Japan, fines for speeding are high.

Types of speeding	Amounts of fines	
	Large vehicles	Standard vehicles
At least 40 km/h and less than 50 km/h	¥40,000	¥35,000
At least 35 km/h and less than 40 km/h	¥30,000	¥25,000
At least 30 km/h and less than 35 km/h	¥25,000	¥18,000
At least 25 km/h and less than 30 km/h	¥20,000	¥15,000
At least 20 km/h and less than 25 km/h	¥15,000	¥12,000

Note2 Roads in Japan are non-parking. Please note that roads in Japan are basically non-parking. Use a designated parking lot or a nearby pay-by-the-hour parking space at sightseeing spots or your accommodation. Fines for illegal parking are more expensive than parking fees!

Once a yellow sticker is attached to your vehicle, your violation will not be voided even if you remove the sticker from your vehicle. To avoid such a case, be sure to park your car in a parking lot.

Examples of information boards along expressways

- ここで出よ 事故通行止**: This means that the route ahead of the information board on the expressway is blocked due to an accident. When you see this display, get off the expressway, and use the general roads.
- 亀山・鈴鹿 渋滞30分**: This means that the section between Kameyama Junction and Suzuka Interchange is experiencing a traffic jam 30 min long. It will take about 10 minutes to pass through the congested section.
- 白鳥・飛騨清見 ユキチェーン装着**: This means that when driving on the expressway between Shiratori Interchange and Hida-Kiyomi Interchange, cars are required to be equipped with winter tires, such as studless tires, or snow chains.
- 中津川・園原 雨50km規制**: This means that the speed limit for the section between Nakatsugawa Interchange and Sonohara Interchange is currently 50 km/h due to rain. If there is no indication, the regular speed limit for an expressway in Japan is 100km/h. There may be cases where the speed limit is 80 km/h or lower.

From the web site, check which rental car agencies carry Central Nippon Expressway Pass (CEP).

CEP is carried at Central Japan International Airport (Nagoya), Kansai International Airport (Osaka), Tokyo International Airport (Tokyo), Toyama Airport, Komatsu Airport, Nariita International Airport, and at major train stations in Nagoya, Tokyo, Yokohama, Kanazawa, Toyama, Kyoto, and Osaka. If using CEP, there are restrictions on which shop you can return your rental car to. Check details when booking your rental. If you plan to borrow and return your rental car at the same shop, all of the agencies support this.

- STEP 4** Rent a rental car and ETC card.
